<p>Special Needs Speech and Language Support Centre (Green Class)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nursery placement through Surrey Panel process for 3-5 year olds • Separate building with specialist equipment • Ability to be separate as well as integrated into the mainstream nursery when appropriate, depending on individual needs of the children • Child height furniture and accessibility • Enclosed spaces • Distraction free withdrawal rooms • Chairs, soft reading chairs, bucket chairs, specialised chairs • High adult/child ratios • Highly specialised and trained staff • All resources accessible to the children • Ramp to main entrance • Child height sink and pegs • Developmental appropriate toys • Sensory room and equipment • Secure rooms (high handles/adult entrance only) • Covered plug sockets • Key operated light switches • Child eye level displays • Child locks on cupboards when appropriate • Outside provision – sensory garden • Makaton signing used, visuals, visual timetables and PECS • Intensive interaction sessions • Regular community visits to reflect the interests and experiences of the child-real life experiences • Speech and Language therapist on site one day a week • Educational Psychologist visits regularly • Delivery of OT and other recommended programmes • Nappy changing facilities (including electric bed) and toilet training • Social stories • Music therapy • Staff regularly research and attend training depending on the needs of the children in the setting (both medical and educational) • Tailored support for individuals • Information books for parents • Regular coffee mornings for parents • Weekly letters for parents • Home school link books for children travelling to Nursery by Taxi • Weekly massage and relaxation sessions • Regular intervention with the Mainstream nursery, including lunchtimes, outside play and intervention afternoons with Mainstream peers. • Regular meetings with parents, Speech Therapist and SENCO • Regular communication with parents through phone calls and e mails
