Targeted Provision Map Short term interventions to support children

2-3s Nursery	3-5s Nursery

- Behaviour plans
- Medical care plans
- Targeted small group intervention including but not limited to Early Talk Boost, ELSA, Talking Time, Attention Autism, Lego Therapy (linked to speech and language/depends on needs of the child)
- Intervention and 1:1 work following recommendations from professional reports and action plans
- Specific group times, differentiated groups to meet the needs of the individuals
- Home-school link books if appropriate
- Food diaries if appropriate
- Toilet charts/lists
- Toilet books
- Focus activities for groups or 1:1
- Visual timetables
- Busy boards to support choice and activity making
- Emotion/behaviour cards and/or boards
- Specified Lunch time seating plans
- Additional Parental meetings with key worker
- Support for parents with strategies in classroom and at Forest School
- Re-arrange environment to meet individual needs
- Regular team discussions about individual children
- Staff training and CPD depending on individual needs in the setting (both medical and educational)
- Tracking and other forms of observation as and when appropriate to inform assessments
- Installation of hand rails, steps for individual needs
- Purchase of seats, pegs for individual
- Child height labels and signs
- Purchase of bikes and other equipment relevant to specific needs
- Bespoke planning for the organisation of the day to meet needs
- Flexible offer of Forest School for individuals, shorter sessions, visual timetable
- SEND Support plan stages 1 and 2
- Food exclusions where appropriate and meeting dietary needs when based on medical need
